Speak words of blessing over your life & your world!

MONTH: JANUARY

SCRIPTURE

Ephesians 4:29, "Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers." NKJV

BLESSING

"When we use the Word of God to declare blessing over a person or situation. The Spirit is released to work accordingly to the blessing of the Lord. You can bless someone by declaring God's intentions over them. Blessings does not focus on what is happening at the moment, but what God originally intended."
